

St. Paul's Memorial Scholarship Fund

Purpose

The St. Paul's Episcopal Church Memorial Scholarship Fund is funded by the Vestry to provide scholarship aid for members of pledging families of St. Paul's and their children who have graduated from high school and who are enrolled in full time college programs. It is administered by the Memorial Scholarship Committee.

Eligibility Criteria

- Candidate has been involved in the life of the Parish for at least three (3) years
- Applicant and his/her family are pledging members of St. Paul's Church
- Applicant is expected to maintain an individual pledging relationship with St. Paul's
- Applicant must have graduated from High School
- Grants are for undergraduate degrees, or for graduate theological studies.
- All grant applications are confidential to the Scholarship Committee.
- Applications must be received by the last business day in April.

Policy Procedures

- The Committee may consult with clergy, Vestry and others who may have useful expertise.
- Notification of grants will be made by Memorial Day.
- Checks will be issued payable jointly to the recipient and the institution of higher learning.
- The maximum grant available is \$1,000 per applicant, per year for undergraduate degrees. Graduate theological students may receive more at the discretion of the committee.
